



Alger Community Recycling

Gateway to Adventure



PURPOSE:

Alger Community Recycling is a partnership between The National Park Service, National Forest Service, City of Munising, Munising Township and the University of Michigan Extension. The group re-established community recycling in 2004 after the collapse of commercial recycling a year earlier and provides oversight and direction of the program. For the past 5 years, the group has worked with both Lakestate Industries in Escanaba, the materials broker and the end customer Manistique Papers, of Manistique to maintain a successful community paper recycling program. Manistique Papers manufacturing process utilizes 60% pre and 40% post consumer recycled fiber in their paper production operation. Sale of recycled paper supports the overall community recycling program. Over 75 TONS of paper have been recycled through this program.
