City Manager's Report

The last couple of weeks at the City have been quiet as the Thanksgiving holiday and the unofficial deer season holiday has a lot of staff and consultants out of the office.

GFL has been scrambling to prepare for the first week of curbside can pick up. As of Monday, December $4^{\rm th}$, GFL has delivered over 400 cans and expects more residents to sign up this month as we head into January. Residents with left over trash tags can bring them into City Hall during the month of December to get reimbursements for unused tags. Information will be collected for those submitted tags and checks will be issued to those residents at the end of the month.

The Superior Watershed Partnership provided an update on the EV Charging Grant that they were awarded this past fall. The City and the County have been working with the Partnership the past few years on identifying grant opportunities that would allow the placement of EV quick chargers at facilities. The partnership was awarded the grant from EGLE this past fall and now have a fully executed grant agreement for the project. UPPCO has been an active partner in the project and they have agreed to donate the time and material needed to facilitate the charging stations. The partnership estimates that the installation and new electric service installations will begin early this summer with installation of the chargers occurring during the summer months.

Reservations for the Munising Tourist Park opened at 8 PM on December 1st. Roughly 2,500 reservations were made in a 72 hour period since the system opened. According to Park Manager, Pat Gariepy, the Camp spot reservation system worked nearly flawlessly as they increased the server capacity to handle the peak demand that occurs during this time period. Pat also noted that the new "No Call- No Show- No Refund" policy that was enacted last year resulted in a steep increase in campers calling and providing updated itineraries which allowed more users to enjoy the facility with fewer empty sites throughout the season.
