4. City Manager Report

City Manager Olson stated that the MDOT bid opening for the M-28 road, water, sewer project, is Friday the 6<sup>th</sup>. We should have a detailed bid breakdown by Monday. There has been 8 bid package addendums in the past week, a minimum of 5 primes have packages. As for the Superior Watershed Tree Grant, they received a grant targeted at waterfront stabilization. Trees will be planted this summer at the Tourist Park, the boat launch and the Anna River access site, around fifty trees total. The City is preparing for spring ditching and dredging, permit applications have been submitted for three sites around frog hollow, north half of Sand Point ditching does not need a permit. We also have permits for sediment removal at the Anna River Kayak launch site. Next, Olson stated the Ice Drag Races are this weekend Mr. McNally has provided the insurance information. Also the event has a State of Michigan MDNR permit for using the bay. Olson advised that any complaints about the event can be directed to County Dispatch. Next, Olson informed the Commission that we are doing a Rental Rehab Application for MEDC, CDBG for the Harley Building, roughly 180k funding to be requested. Units are required to all be long term and one-unit affordable rate for 5 years. MEDC is processing the application at this time. As for the Public Works Department they will be returning to day shift, so March 9<sup>th</sup> a full day shift will be in place. Last, Olson informed the Commission that a new copier should be here late this week or early next week.
