The following questions have been submitted by 4:00 PM on Tuesday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023:

1. Is the 825 homes number accurate?

- a. This is a number pulled from our utility billing system for residential services. Per the RFP, this is an approximated number and it is the responsibility of the bidder self-verify prior to the submission of the proposal

2. How are we currently billing users of the service?

- a. The City currently sells tags that are produced by the City and sold to residential customers. The current provider than bills the City for the cost of the route, tipping fee, and any surcharges. The City uses the tag revenue to cover the cost of operations billed to the City by the current provider. Tags sales originate in City Hall where residents can purchase directly but are also retailed at a local bank as well as a grocery store. Please note the RFP does not relate to this type of resident, municipality, and waster hauler relationship.

3. What was our tonnage per year?

- a. The billed monthly and weekly breakdown is below, 280.35 Tons in total.
